### 2. Transport to and from the airport

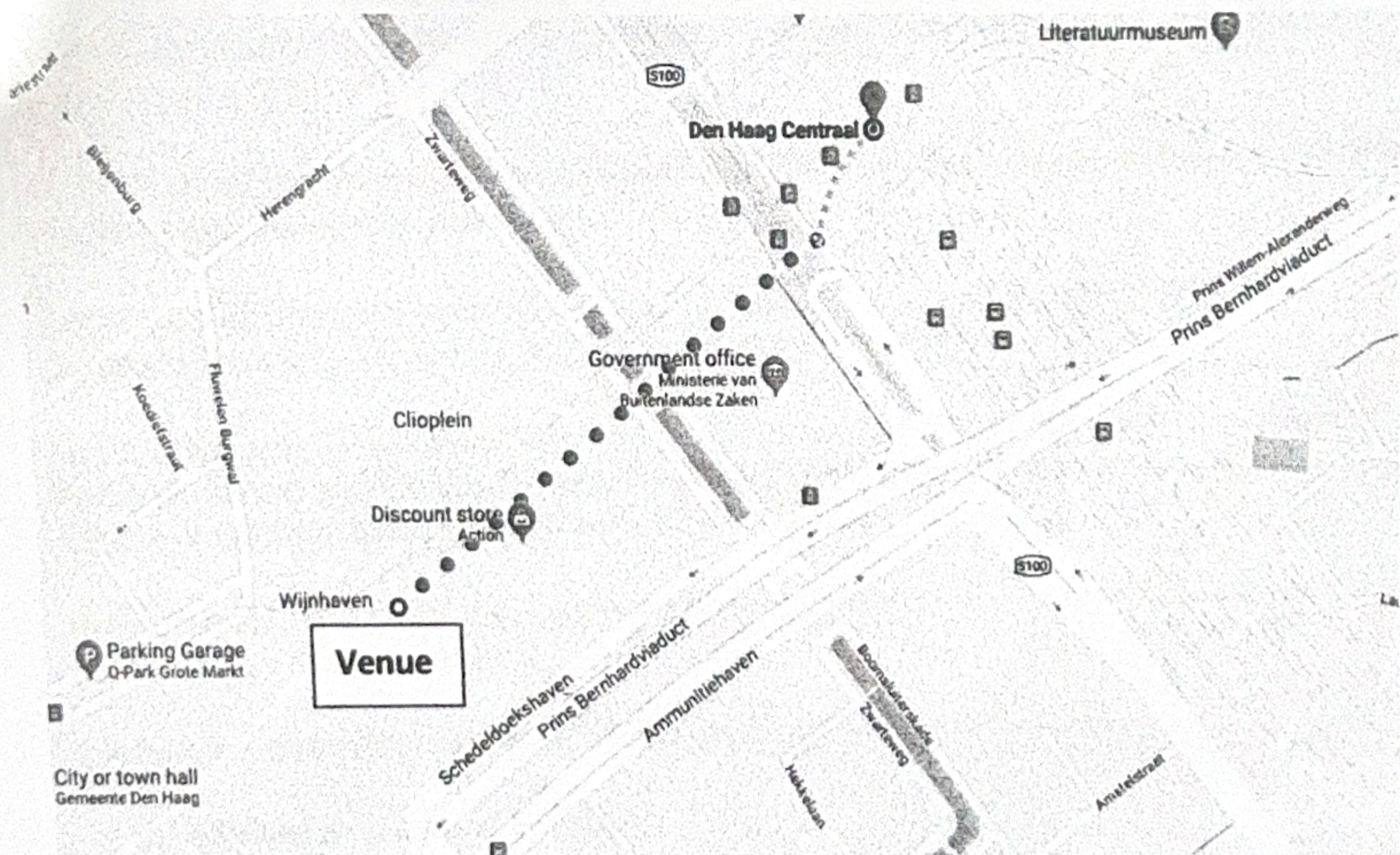

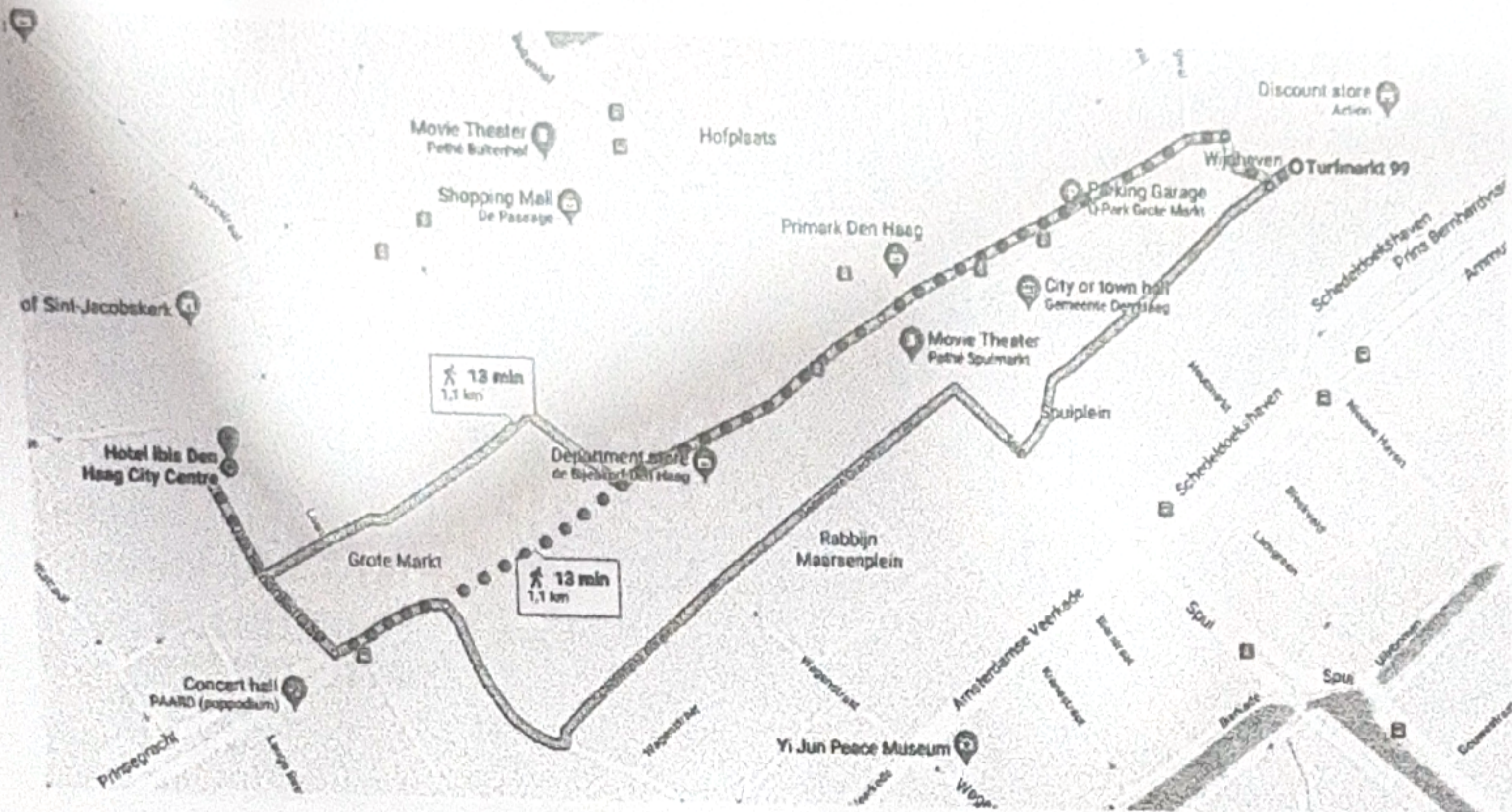


### 4. Hotel
