Full participation involves going through a selection process and presenting a paper. Listening participation is also possible, but numbers are limited. Registration is obligatory (deadline: 20 February 2004).

Listening participants have to pay a flat fee of € 90 which covers scheduled meals and the CD-ROM including all the papers of the Meeting. Students and Faculty of the EUI and Tuscan universities, members of SesAMO (Italian Society for Middle Eastern Studies), and officials of the Regione Toscana are exempt from this payment. Proof of affiliation will be requested.

After registration, listening participants should take care of their own accommodation and transportation.

The Mediterranean Social and Political Research Meeting was held in Florence for the first time in March 2004, and has become one of the major gatherings in Europe of social scientists working on the Middle East and North Africa (MENA) and the relationship between Europe and the MENA. Among other things, it aims to contribute to a better understanding between the two shores of the Mediterranean.

For the fifth Meeting, the European University Institute welcomes approximately 250 academics—both junior and senior—from Europe, the Middle East and North Africa, who for three days will discuss original research papers on fourteen different topics, each supervised by two workshop directors. Workshop topics and directors vary from one Meeting to another.

Florence, city of culture with its long history of intellectual exchanges, is the perfect setting for such a Meeting, and in particular the European University Institute, which since its creation in 1976 has developed a tradition of intellectual debates in a multicultural and multinational environment.

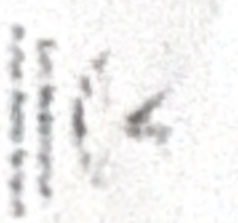
